**COMPLAINT**

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I****Charge: Murder-Unborn Child-2nd Deg-Not Premeditated**

Minnesota Statute: 609.2662(1), with reference to: 609.2662, 609.11.5(a), 609.17.4(2)

Maximum Sentence: 40 YEARS, HALF OF

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 04/16/2021

Control #(ICR#): 21079430

Charge Description: That on or about April 16, 2021, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, Cameron Oneal Clark, attempted to cause the death of an unborn child, with intent to effect the death of that person, or another, without premeditation, while possessing a firearm.

Minimum Sentence: 3 YEARS

**COUNT II****Charge: Aggravated Robbery-1st Degree**

Maximum Sentence: 20 YEARS AND/OR \$35,000

Offense Level: Felony

Charge Description: That on or about April 16, 2021, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, Cameron Oneal Clark, acting alone or intentionally aiding, advising, hiring, counseling or conspiring with another, or otherwise procures the other to commit the crime, took personal property from the person or in the presence of known-adult Victim, knowing that he was not entitled to the property and used and/or threatened the imminent use of force against Victim to overcome her resistance or powers of resistance to

or to compel acquiescence in the taking or carrying away of the property, and inflicted bodily harm upon  
Victim while possessing a firearm.

Minimum Sentence: 3 YEARS

**STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE**

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On April 16, 2021, officers with the Minneapolis Police Department received a walk-in report of an aggravated robbery that occurred at an apartment complex, located at 12XX Banneker Avenue, Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota.

Specifically, a known-adult Victim told officers that she went to meet up with the father of her unborn child, identified as CAMERON ONEAL CLARK (DOB: 1/11/1991; hereinafter "Defendant Clark"), when she was maced by a woman, subsequently identified as TANISHA AMIEA MARIE DUNN (DOB: 7/15/1984; "Defendant Dunn"). After being maced, Victim grabbed for her firearm in an attempt to defend herself, but Defendant Clark then came up from behind her and tased Victim on the left side of her abdomen. Both Defendants began to beat Victim. They punched and kicked her, targeting Victim's abdomen. Victim is 6 months pregnant.

After they were done beating her, Defendants stole Victim's firearm and cell phone before fleeing out of the apartment. Victim walked to a nearby store and called her uncle for a ride to the police precinct. Victim received medical care and was diagnosed with a broken rib. Her baby still appeared to have a heartbeat, and no ruptures or internal bleeding were noted. Medical records were requested.

Officers obtained video surveillance of the assault. The video has good resolution and shows events consistent with Victim's report. The video also shows Defendant Clark methodically circle around Victim, so he faces her stomach. Once her stomach is exposed, he braces himself against the wall and kicks her directly in the stomach. Defendants strike Victim an innumerable number of times with their fists, feet, and eventually a taser.

Law enforcement executed a search warrants for Defendants' apartments and Defendant Clark's vehicle. Numerous items were seized, including a large amount of US currency and two bottles of mace.

In subsequent interviews, Victim stated she met Defendant Clark in approximately February of 2019. The two had a sporadic sexual relationship until November 2020 when Victim became pregnant with Defendant Clark's child. After learning of the pregnancy, Defendant Clark constantly pressured Victim to have an abortion. He would also make threats about having people jump her to make her lose the baby. Victim recalled him saying, "I'm gonna get somebody to stomp that baby out of you."

Defendants are in custody.

Defendant Clark has a lengthy criminal history, including four open drug cases (See Court File Numbers: 27-CR-20-6193, 27-CR-19-5275, 27-CR-18-30152 and 27-CR-18-29983) During the execution of the search warrant at his home, officers also located contraband and items associated with drug sale. The firearm was not located. Given the severity of the offense and Defendant Clark's risk to public safety, the State is requesting high bail.

**SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS**

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
