COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

Amended

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Murder - 2nd Degree - With Intent-Not Premeditated

Minnesota Statute: 609.19.1(1), with reference to: 609.19.1

Maximum Sentence: 40 years

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 05/26/2021 to 06/16/2021

Control #(ICR#): 21014003

Charge Description: cause the death of K.A. with intent to effect the death of the victim or another, but without premeditation

COUNT II

Charge: Assault-2nd Degree-Dangerous Weapon

Minnesota Statute: 609.222.1, with reference to: 609.222.1

Maximum Sentence: 7 years and \$14,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 05/26/2021 to 05/26/2021

Control #(ICR#): 21014003

Charge Description: assault another, to-wit: A.A., with a dangerous weapon, to wit: metal cylinder

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

The Complainant states that the following facts establish probable cause:

On 05/26/2021 at approximately 12:45 am Woodbury Officers were called to the area of 479 Lake View Alcove, Woodbury, Washington County for the report of an adult female chasing a child down the street and of a child screaming. There were multiple 911 calls in the area reporting the same.

Officers arrived on scene at approximately 12:49 am and observed a child, who was later identified as A.A. DOB: 01/02/2015 running in the street, away from his mother. The mother was identified as Sadiyo Ibrahim MOHAMED DOB: 05/05/1989, herein Defendant. When officers made contact with the Defendant, she appeared to be staring off into the distance and saying an unknown Somali phrase repeatedly.

The Defendant was taken into custody and while in the rear of the squad car, she slipped out of the handcuffs. After a minor altercation, officers were able to use a control hold and get the handcuffs placed back on the Defendant.

Officers heard several people yelling that there was a dead baby in the street and located a female child, 5 to 6 years old, lying supine in the street between units 441 and 479 Lake View Alc. She was later identified as K.A. DOB: 01/30/2016. Officers observed a puddle of blood coming from her head and minor lacerations and abrasions to both the left and right side of her face. Her hair was soaked in blood and there was an apparent wound to the rear side of her head. K.A. had shallow breathing and a pulse. Her eyes were partially open, but would not respond to stimulus and she was unresponsive to questions or touch.

A.A. had a possible broken arm. A.A. and K.A. were transported by Woodbury EMS to Regions Hospital.

On the sidewalk in front of the residence, officers observed a pool of blood and directly next to it was a long skinny piece of wood or similar type of object.

During a Miranda interview, Defendant stated that she has a mental illness and had been diagnosed with bipolar disorder. She said she has been off her medications for a couple months. She had been trying to clean her house all day and has been paranoid and hallucinating for the last couple of days. She believed her kids were playing games on her, which made her confused. She said she wasn't sure if her kids were the devil or a demon which made her question if she should hurt them or not. She finished the interview by stating she was sick, confused and that she didn't know any better and also that she was very aggressive and could not take care of her kids or herself. She said she had been hospitalized in the past at Regions Hospital, around 2012, for mental health reasons.

While clearing the residence of 463 Lake View Alc., they located a young child (1-2 years old) inside. The child appeared to be unharmed. That child was later identified as A.A. DOB: 01/13/2018. The child was turned over to Washington County Child Protection and Det. Lund, completed a hold form for all three children.

Officers noted the house was in disarray with items scattered throughout.

While speaking with neighbors, one reported making contact with the juvenile male, A.A. who told her that the female was his mother and that she had hit him and his sister. She said A.A. appeared to be cold, shaking uncontrollably and seemed very scared.

Several neighbors were interviewed and reported hearing a child screaming from outside for several minutes and hearing what sounded like slaps or thumps. One neighbor reported seeing an adult female standing near the child on the ground and a male child standing behind the adult. The adult became upset and began chasing the male child who ran away. Another neighbor reported hearing a child yelling "mommy" and heard another person yell, "call the police"

Det. Lund went to Regions Hospital with Washington County Social Worker Whitcomb to speak with A.A. A.A. reported that his mom had kicked him out of the house. Prior to that, she had hit him and his older sister (older of his two sisters). They did not do anything and did not know why his mom was mad. When his mom was hitting him, he told her to stop. She hit him on his arm and head with a hard object. He saw his mom hit his sister all over her body, lots of times. His sister was saying "sorry mommy" and his mom was saying that she didn't trust her (his sister). That all happened outside. His littlest sister didn't get hit, she was asleep on the couch. He was awake before all of this happened, but wasn't doing anything. His mom has hit them in the past. Only he, his two sisters and his mom live in the home. He described the item she hit them with a gray cylinder approximately 12 inches long. He didn't know what it was made of. She had hit him and his sister with that before lots of times. She keeps the object in her closet in the bedroom, down low. He felt scared when this was happening. His mom had been chasing him, but he got away. Det. Lund observed some bruises on A.A.'s upper and lower arms. The bruises appeared to have markings consistent with being struck with a cylindrical type of object. He also had a very large hematoma on his head above his right eye.

Doctors at Regions Hospital advised that K.A. required emergency surgery and was in critical condition with injuries including, but not limited to, a skull fracture, brain bleed, a lacerated liver, and broken ribs. K.A.'s entire body is covered in bruising and lacerations. A.A. did not have any fractures or broken bones, but his right arm is severely bruised, there is swelling of his wrist and he has a large contusion on the right side of his forehead. The bruises are consistent with a cylinder shaped object.

On 6/16/2021, law enforcement learned that K.A. had been taken off life support that morning and passed away 21 minutes later at 1121 a.m.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.

Complainant declares under penalty of perjury that everything stated in this document is true and correct. Minn. Stat. § 358.116; Minn. R. Crim. P. 2.01, subds. 1, 2.

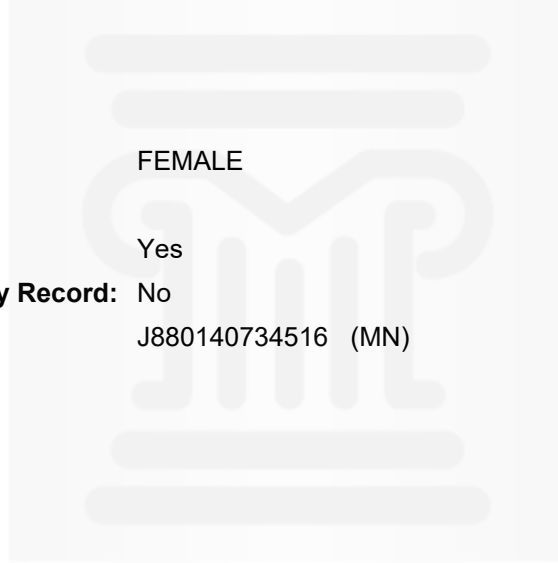

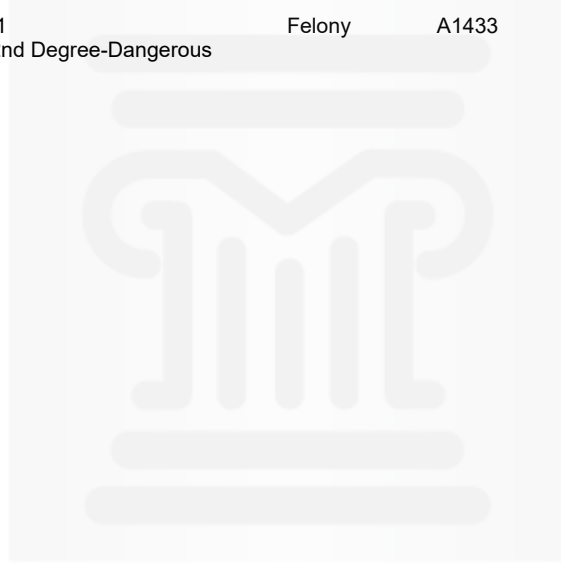
