STIPULATION AND ORDER

Stipulation

This Stipulation is made and entered into by and between Feeding Our Future and the Minnesota Department of Education (“MDE”) (collectively, the “Parties”).

WHEREAS, Feeding Our Future brought a Motion for an Emergency Temporary Restraining Order and Injunction (the “Motion”); and

WHEREAS, the Parties stipulate and agree to resolve the Motion according to the following terms:

1. MDE will approve or disapprove Feeding Our Future's CACFP and SFSP applications that are correct and complete in a reasonably prompt manner. If MDE receives a CACFP or SFSP application from Feeding Our Future that it believes is incomplete or incorrect, it will notify Feeding Our Future why it believes the application is incorrect or incomplete and will provide Feeding Our Future any technical assistance that might be appropriate to correct or complete the application.

2. Nothing in this Stipulation shall:
- a. constitute an admission by MDE as to any of the factual or legal issues raised in the Motion or Plaintiff's Complaint and Jury Demand filed in the Action;
 - b. constitute an admission by Feeding Our Future as to any of the factual or legal issues raised in the Motion or MDE's Answer and Affirmative Defenses;
 - c. act as a waiver of any claim, cause of action, or defense asserted by either party in the Action; or
3. The Parties agree that the terms of this Stipulation are to be incorporated in a court order that will remain in place until further order of the court.
