SENTENCE

Stay of Execution. On count 2, you are sentenced to the custody of the Hennepin County Adult Correctional Facility (ACF) for 364 days. Execution of this sentence is stayed for two years. You are placed on probation for this amount of time. Time served on probation out of custody will not count toward any prison term if probation is revoked.

The following is dismissed: Count 1 on 27-CR-22-15593, pursuant to the plea agreement.

LOCAL CONFINEMENT

- Serve 120 days in the ACF, with credit for three days.
 - Report to the ACF by 5:00 p.m. on July 11, 2023.
 - If eligible, you are approved for immediate furloughs for job-seeking and work/school.

CONDITIONS OF PROBATION

(Follow all Standard Probation Conditions and Probation Rules.)

- Call your probation officer (Brian O'Rourke, 612-543-1974) within one week.
- Do not possess or use any firearm or ammunition.


FINANCIAL

(Pay any amount ordered within six months.)

- No restitution was sought.
- Pay the \$75 surcharge.
- Pay the \$50 fine.
- Pay the \$3 law library fee.
- Any active appearance bond is discharged.

- This sentence is a downward durational departure from the Minnesota Sentencing Guidelines.

STANDARD PROBATION CONDITIONS

It is your responsibility to follow all of these conditions of probation and rules of the Hennepin County Department of Community Corrections and Rehabilitation Adult Fields Services ("Probation"). You must stay in contact with your Probation Officer. If you have any question about these conditions of your probation or the rules of Probation, contact your Probation Officer. If you do not have the name and number of your Probation Officer, contact Probation at 612-348-2110 or poconnect@hennepin.us.

1. Follow all State and Federal criminal laws.
2. Contact your probation officer as directed.
3. Tell your probation officer within 72 hours if you have contact with law enforcement.
4. Tell your probation officer within 72 hours if you are charged with any new crime.
5. Tell your probation officer within 72 hours if you change your address, employment, or telephone number.
6. Cooperate with the search of your person, residence, vehicle, workplace, property, and things as directed by your probation officer.
7. Sign releases of information as directed by your probation officer.
8. Give a DNA sample when directed by your probation officer.

NOTE: If you disagree with your probation officer regarding the interpretation of the terms or conditions of probation, you may return to court for clarification.
