The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Firearm-Serial Number-Receive/Possess With No Serial Number

Minnesota Statute: 609.667(3), with reference to: 609.667

Maximum Sentence: Not more than five years imprisonment and/or \$10,000 fine

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 05/26/2022

Control #(ICR#): 22013566

Charge Description: On or about 5/26/2022, within the County of Sherburne, the defendant, Matthew Walker Anderson, D.O.B. 6/26/2001, did receive or possess a firearm that is not identified by a serial number.

COUNT II

Charge: Firearm-Serial Number-Receive/Possess With No Serial Number

Minnesota Statute: 609.667(3), with reference to: 609.667

Maximum Sentence: Not more than five years imprisonment and/or \$10,000 fine

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 05/26/2022

Charge Description: On or about 5/26/2022, within the County of Sherburne, the defendant, Matthew Walker Anderson, D.O.B. 6/26/2001, did receive or possess a firearm that is not identified by a serial number.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Your Complainant is an officer with the Sherburne County Sheriff's Office. In this capacity your Complainant believes the following to be true and correct.

On May 26, 2022, at approximately 6:35 PM, Deputy Wivoda with the Sherburne County Sheriff's Office was dispatched to a residence in Santiago Township, Sherburne County, Minnesota, regarding damage to property. The complainant, M.R., reported he was standing in the kitchen of his residence when he heard glass shatter on a lower level. M.R. investigated and found the glass sliding door was shattered, he believed from a gunshot. M.R. reported hearing gunshots coming from the north.

During the course of his investigation, Deputy Wivoda made contact with Matthew Walker Anderson, D.O.B. 6/26/2001, who was in a motor vehicle leaving an address off 160th Ave SE, which is north of the incident location. Anderson admitted to shooting while at the residence with his friend. Deputy Wivoda returned to the residence with Anderson and observed the targets with numerous bullet holes on a wooded backdrop. The individuals were advised of the incident and instructed to have a proper backstop.

During the investigation, Deputy Wivoda inspected the firearms used by Anderson and his friend. Anderson identified owning two rifles which Deputy Wivoda determined were unregistered and without serial numbers. One rifle was identified as a black .223 caliber AR-15 rifle with a black Tasco reflex sight. The second was identified as a black .308 caliber AR-10 rifle with a black scope. Anderson resides in Becker, Sherburne County, Minnesota, and the residence he was shooting at is located in Clear Lake, Sherburne County, Minnesota.

Anderson advised he had pieced the firearms together by purchasing all the items separately from various sources. Anderson advised neither firearm was identified by serial number.

Deputy Turner responded to assist. He performed function checks on the firearms and determined they were in working condition. He also verified they did not have any identifying marks or serial numbers.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE: Pursuant to Minn. Stat. 609.49., intentional failure to appear for duly scheduled court appearances may result in additional criminal charges, and in addition to any arrest warrant that may otherwise be issued by the Court.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.

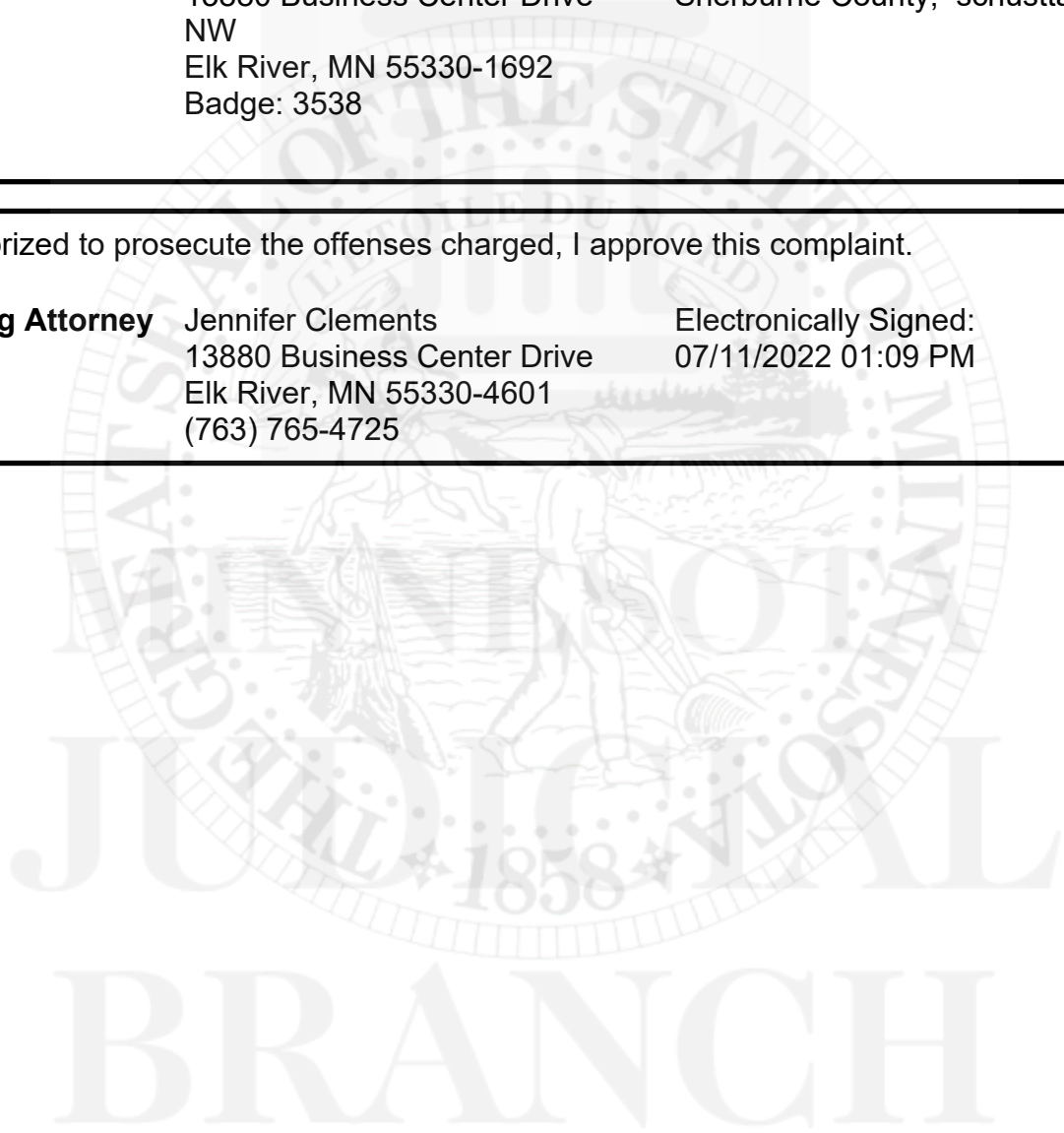
