 Info report from 640 Jackson St (Regions Hospital)

Narrative :
 No ICC
 BWC was activated and reviewed prior to report.
 I, Sgt A. Rahlf, B161 was working COT at 640 Jackson St (Regions Hospital) on 01/10/26 at approx. 1715 hours.
 As I arrived at Regions, I spoke with a security officer that advised me the Vice President of the City Council was in the lobby. As I walked through the lobby, I recognized HWA JEONG KIM from a previous encounter.
 Security Supervisor Andy told me that there was family here for a private patient and that KIM was there for the same private patient. I was advised that the patient was in custody and per hospital policy, there are no visitors for in custody patients.
 As I was getting updated by Security Supervisor Andy I saw the family, a Regions Hospital Health Unit Coordinator and another Regions Hospital staff from registration standing near the door entrance to the Emergency dept. I saw one of the visitors had a sticker for the room the private patient was in, and the coordinator was trying to bring them back through the doors. I pointed this out to Andy, and we approached the group.
 Security Supervisor Andy told me he had spoken to KIM and addressed her as Vice President Hwa Jeong Kim and introduced himself and advised her she needed to leave Regions Hospital, which he said she did.
 Three additional females arrived to be with the family. One female handed her phone towards Security Supervisor Nhia and told him she has EDMUNDO LIJO, the assistant city attorney for the City of St Paul, on the phone. LIJO said his office has communicated with Dr Skarda at Regions and

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she is communicating with hospital leadership about the federal warrant. LIJO stated he is on his way down to the hospital and he knows Dr Skarda is in communication with hospital leadership. I clarified Dr Skarda has called and released information that there is a patient here. He hesitated and he believes she is calling leadership.

Supervisor Nhia reiterated to the group that they all need to leave per hospital policy. I advised the group that if they did not leave, they would be trespassed.

One of the females in the group began taking pictures and had to be asked to delete the pictures as there is no video or pictures in the hospital for HIPAA concerns.

LIJO arrived on scene and asked me for information. I told him I could not release any information, and he could talk to the family. Two additional females arrived to also provide legal counsel.

All parties eventually left Region's property without incident. Nothing further.

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
