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STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Your Complainant is a licensed peace officer employed by the Pine County Sheriff's Office. In this capacity your Complainant believes the following to be true and correct.

On or about July 1, 2015, Pine County Sheriff's Office Investigator Rick Giese interviewed a sixteen year-old male with the fictitious initials ABC. ABC reported that he met Nathan Lawrence Johnson (DOB 10/29/1977), hereinafter defendant, through a mutual friend. ABC reported that a short while after meeting the defendant, the defendant sent him a message on Facebook and they began to exchange messages back and forth.

In April 2015, when ABC was fifteen years old, ABC recalled that the defendant asked ABC if he wanted to clean his (the defendant's) house at a rate of \$20.00/hour. ABC agreed and cleaned his house that same day; the defendant's house is located in Pine City, Pine County, Minnesota. ABC received a pack of Marlboro red 100s and a tin of tobacco chew from the defendant after cleaning his house. A few days later, the defendant asked ABC if he wanted to come over and clean the defendant's house again. ABC agreed to do so and while there, the defendant asked ABC if he wanted a back massage. ABC laid on the defendant's couch on his stomach and the defendant got on top of ABC, straddling him and sitting on the back of ABC's upper thighs. ABC stated that the defendant put his hands inside ABC's shirt and was thrusting his "boner" (a slang term for an erect penis) against ABC's butt. The defendant got off of ABC to get some lotion and ABC told the defendant not to get on him again. ABC and the defendant then sat on the couch and the defendant reached over and grabbed ABC's genitals and squeezed them. ABC swatted the defendant away and told the defendant he was uncomfortable with the defendant doing that. The defendant apologized.

ABC turned sixteen in May 2015, and sometime after ABC's birthday, the defendant asked ABC if ABC wanted to come over. The defendant picked ABC up at his house and drove the McDonald's in Pine City. ABC reported that on the way to McDonald's, the defendant grabbed ABC's genitals again and said since ABC was now 16, the defendant was allowed to "touch him as much as he wants" but that he has "to stop when you say stop."

Investigator Bradley Carlson received and reviewed the records from Facebook beginning February, 2016. The records show that the defendant first messaged ABC on or about July 26, 2014, and the last of the messages from the defendant on or about June 20, 2015. On the first day of messaging, the defendant asked ABC when he would be 16 and followed that question with "that's the legal age."

In August 2014, ABC asks the defendant to get him 2 tins of grizzly wintergreen chewing tobacco. The next series of messages show that the defendant agreed and purchased the chewing tobacco, brought it to ABC's house and received money from ABC to cover the cost. The defendant tells ABC that ABC will have to send pictures of himself shirtless and flexing his bicep in exchange for the tobacco; ABC sends the requested photos.

During the evening of August 30 and into the morning hours of September 1, 2014, ABC again asks for the defendant to get him chewing tobacco. The defendant ultimately agrees in exchange for three more photos from ABC of his body. The defendant drops off the chewing tobacco at ABC's house and after the defendant messages "here," ABC sends the requested photos of himself (including a photo of ABC in boxer briefs only).

September 14, 2014, following a discussion about meeting up with the defendant, ABC sent a message saying he (ABC) "even let you give me a massage." The defendant responded with "that was for you" and ABC told the defendant "You got turned on I know you did."

Upon review of all of the Facebook records, the defendant also purchased for, and provided tobacco products to, ABC at his house on or about September 21, 2014; November 9, 2014; March 13, 2015; and April 14, 2015. ABC's house is in Pine City, Pine County, Minnesota.

The above incident occurred within the County of Pine, State of Minnesota.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE: Pursuant to Minn. Stat. 609.49., intentional failure to appear for duly scheduled court appearances may result in additional criminal charges, and in addition to any arrest warrant that may otherwise be issued by the Court.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:

- (1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
- (2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.

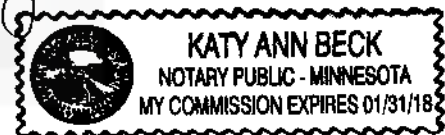
