The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Murder - 2nd Degree - With Intent-Not Premeditated**  
Minnesota Statute: 609.19.1(1), with reference to: 609.19.1, 609.11.5  
Maximum Sentence: Imprisonment for Not More Than 40 Years  
Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 05/27/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26014973

Charge Description: On or about May 27, 2026, in the City of Shakopee, County of Scott, MOHAMED ABDIRIZAK RAGE, Defendant, date of birth 06/07/1997, did cause the death of a human being with intent to effect the death of that person or another, but without premeditation.

**COUNT II**

**Charge: Possess Ammo/Any Firearm - Conviction or Adjudicated Delinquent for Crime of Violence**  
Minnesota Statute: 624.713.1(2), with reference to: 624.713.2(b)  
Maximum Sentence: 15 years and/or \$30,000.  
Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 05/27/2026

Charge Description: On or about May 27, 2026, in the City of Shakopee, County of Scott, MOHAMED ABDIRIZAK RAGE, Defendant, date of birth 06/07/1997, possessed a firearm and is not entitled to possess ammunition or a pistol or semiautomatic military-style assault weapon as he has been convicted of a crime of violence: Assault in the Third Degree: 27-CR-21-7112.

**STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE**

The Complainant states that the following facts establish probable cause:

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On May 27, 2026, at approximately 9:55 a.m., officers of the Shakopee Police Department are dispatched to Canterbury Park located in Shakopee, Scott County, Minnesota on a weapons complaint. Officers learned from dispatch that an individual, hereinafter Victim, had been shot, was in the parking lot in front of the Expo Center, and the shooter was no longer on scene. Upon arrival, officers saw a large crowd of people in front of the Expo Center and saw Victim lying on his back receiving medical attention. At this point, Victim was conscious, alert and breathing. Victim was able to identify himself by name. Officers observed a gunshot wound to Victim's chest, but it was not actively bleeding. Officers observed an injury to Victim's chin. Victim stated that he could feel himself "filling up with blood" in his chest and stomach area. Victim kept saying "I can't breathe, please help me." As he was being treated at the scene, Victim was going in and out of consciousness. Victim was transported from the scene via ambulance to HCMC for further medical care. In the area the victim was laying, Officers recovered a single 9mm shell casing.

On the scene, officers spoke to Victim's wife, hereinafter A.D.Y. who stated that Victim and herself were exiting the Expo center when they were approached by a male, later identified as MOHAMED ABDIRIZAK RAGE, date of birth 6/7/1997, Defendant herein. A.D.Y. stated that Defendant told Victim that he wanted to fight him. Victim did not want to fight Defendant as Victim was with his wife. Victim told Defendant, "Please leave me alone, I don't want to fight." A.D.Y. stated that Victim and herself were walking through the parking lot to go home and Defendant followed them. A.D.Y. did not know how close Defendant was to Victim when he shot him but stated that Victim tried to run. A.D.Y. stated that Victim was shot behind a car. A.D.Y. gave a physical description of Defendant to officers.

Detective Schneck spoke with A.D.Y. via phone about the shooting incident. Aside from earlier information she provided at the scene, A.D.Y. stated that Defendant was telling Victim, "Let's go" and was recording them with a cell phone. A.D.Y. stated that a physical altercation took place and an unknown male tried to intervene in the fight. A.D.Y. stated that Defendant took out a gun while Victim tried to hide. A.D.Y. stated Defendant fired 1-2 shots and then fled on foot. Victim fell to the ground. A.D.Y. found a phone on the ground that she thought belonged to Defendant--that phone was given to officers at the scene.

While conducting witness interviews, Detective Schneck learned that Victim died at HCMC. The medical examiner's office transported Victim's body to their office where an autopsy was conducted on May 28, 2026. Officers spoke to the medical examiner's office and learned that the preliminary cause and manner of death was single gunshot wound to the torso and homicide.

Officers spoke to a known adult male, A.A.H. who stated that he was at the Expo center for the morning prayer service. He stated that while in the parking lot--he saw a male punching another male. A.A.H. stated that the two males were fighting by his sister's vehicle. A.A.H. stated that he broke up the fight. He stated that one of the males pulled out a gun and shot 1-2 times at the other male who fell to the ground. A.A.H. stated that the male who shot the gun was wearing an all-white khami while the male who was shot was wearing a black or brown khami.

Officers spoke to a known adult male, A.S.M. who stated that he was at the morning prayer service at the

Expo center. A.S.M. stated that he was walking behind Victim and Victim's wife. A.S.M. saw a Somali male taking pictures or video of Victim. A.S.M. heard Victim tell the Somali male to stop. The Somali male followed Victim into the parking lot. A.S.M. stated that Victim punched the Somali male. After the physical altercation was over, A.S.M. saw the Somali male pull a gun out of his pocket and load the gun. In an effort to explain to officers what he meant by loading the gun, A.S.M. made a motion with his hands as if the Somali male was racking a semi-automatic handgun. A.S.M. stated that Victim ran away with his hands covering his head. A.S.M. stated that the Somali male fired two shots at Victim and then the Somali male fled on foot. A.S.M. followed the Somali male and saw him get into a vehicle. A.S.M. was able to provide a physical description of the suspect vehicle along with a partial license plate number to officers.

Officers were able to obtain and review surveillance of the shooting. The surveillance footage shows Defendant dressed in a long white garment with a red/maroon scarf over his shoulders. He began walking from the parking lot toward the building at Canterbury Park. Defendant appeared to be approaching the building with a female dressed in a maroon outfit. He returned to the car, a white SUV by himself. He then re-approached the building alone. Defendant enters the building and walks through the lobby. At 9:52 a.m. Defendant enters the Expo Lobby once again. Almost immediately afterward, Defendant appeared to be acting animatedly and gestured toward the Victim who was wearing a long black garment. The female in maroon, presumably the same female with whom Defendant initially approached the building, stepped between the males, seemingly to keep them separate. Victim and a different female exit the Expo Lobby doors to the parking lot. Approximately four seconds later, Defendant got past the female trying to restrain him and exited the same door.

Defendant follows Victim outside, after which a physical fight broke out between the two of them. Bystanders broke up the fight. Then at 9:54 a.m., Defendant chased Victim with his arm extended. Victim remained upright and walked around for a short time before he collapsed to the ground. Bystanders immediately tended to him. The female who was with Defendant walked directly to a car, the same white SUV Defendant was previously observed at. She walked to that vehicle immediately after exiting the building and wasn't in the vicinity of the shooting. Defendant ran a short distance away and appeared to be reapproaching the scene twice before running off. He enters the white SUV and gets inside the passenger door, after which the SUV backs up and leaves the area.

Defendant was identified by his phone which was left at the scene, witness statements, the vehicle he arrived and left in, and photographs of the suspect compared to known photos of Defendant.

On May 28, 2026, Defendant turned himself in at the Shakopee Police Department.

Law enforcement collected evidence at the scene, through search warrants of vehicles and residences and various devices which are currently being processed.

A check of Defendant's criminal history shows a conviction for Assault in the Third Degree, court file number 27-CR-21-7112, which makes him ineligible to possess a firearm.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.

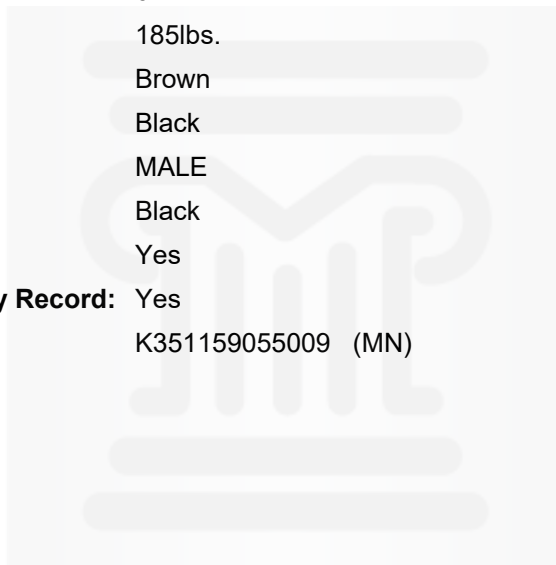
